Message from Mr. Krafft & Mrs. Deevoy

As a school we were making huge strides in improving our attendance figures and reducing the number of pupils who were late or persistently absent. Unfortunately, covid struck and schools up and down the country have struggled to return to precovid attendance levels – we are no different.

Now, more than ever, it is important that children access a full and consistent education. After numerous years of disruption, pupils need to catch up with missed learning as well as continuing to build for their futures. It is clear from our data that poor attendance and lateness is having a negative impact on the progress of those pupils. In the spirit of openness, it is important to share that the school is also being judged by the local authority and Ofsted on its attendance levels. This is not a message aimed at chastising or threatening consequences, it is more an appeal for mutual support. We understand that at the end of term we faced difficult weather conditions, usual winter illnesses and let's not ignore the scary stories reported in the national media.

We want to work together to get the overall attendance level back up to 96%. The school are here to support you in any way we can. We, the team and especially Mrs Musk, can work with you or your children if they are finding things difficult and we are looking at ways to normalise good attendance for the pupils – any suggestions on this front would be welcome.

So, from here on you may have more members of staff calling to see how things are going if your children are off school and we will be shutting the office for payments and general enquiries from 8:50 – 9:50 to ensure attendance can be our priority first thing in the morning. Please ensure your children are here by 8:45 every morning as this is when lessons start.

We know you will support us in this, the same as you always do, and we look forward to hearing suggestions and working with you to collectively improve attendance throughout the school.
