We have already enjoyed some enriching experiences with the Rabel Charters Art and History workshop. In term 2 we will be learning about:

English – Katie in London (Letter writing, descriptions and narrative). Coming to England – Floella Benjamin.

Phonics – We are really focussing on securing the children’s knowledge of phase 3 and 5 in preparation for the statutory phonics screening check. Please continue to practise these with your children. It is also very important that all children are reading at least 3x a week at home to develop their fluency.

Maths – Place Value, and length and perimeter.

Geography – Comparing London to the countryside.

Science – Plants.

RE – Why is Easter important to Christians.

PE – Hit, catch and run.

ICT – Grouping data.
