


Term 4 2022

World Book Day



World Book Day is being held on Thursday 2nd March this year. We would like to extend this to the whole week from Monday 27th February - Friday 3rd March so that all children can participate in this event. Throughout this week we will be sharing stories, looking at different authors and if they would like to, children can dress up on any day as their favourite character. Children can bring in books from home to share with us and we will have lots of different activites planned around our favourite stories. Your child will also be receiving a World Book Day Token, which can be used in participating shops.

Science week
