What an outstanding term! I have seen the children flourish so much this term throughout the whole curriculum. It has been wonderful getting to know everyone and meeting everyone at parents evening.

Next term we are:

In Science we will be learning about Forces.

Key vocabulary to learn: forces, friction, surface, magnetic, repel, attract

In History our focus will be 'Bronze Age and Iron Age'. We will be looking at the smelting process, what life was like and how it changed as well as recreating some Iron Age art.

Key vocabulary to learn: smelting, ores, trade, hillfort, grave goods, brooch, celtic.

In English we will be reading 'The Pebble in My Pocket' by Meredith Hooper, "The Street Beneath My Feet" by Charlotte Guillian and "UG" by Raymond Briggs. We will be focusing on non-fiction writing by creating non-chronological reports.

In Maths we will begin the term by continuing with addition and subtraction where we will continue to work on securing our use of column method to work out number sentences. We then move onto multiplication and division which will be when we learn our 3, 4 and 8 times table.
