Uniform:

This term we are:

In history we will be learning about Ancient Greece. This will feed into our English lessons where we will be reading *Who Let The Gods Out* by Maz Evans. This book is both thought provoking and funny and gives me lots of opportunities to practise my voices for the characters! We will be writing narratives, newspaper articles and diary entries.

In Maths we will begin the term by looking at Place Value and we will then move on to Addition and Subtraction.

In RE our big question will be '*God – What does it mean if God is holy and loving?*'.

In Science we will be investigating Materials – we will be looking at changes both reversible and irreversible, classifying materials and thermal conductivity.

Key vocabulary to learn:

Democracy, philosophy, reversible, irreversible, conductivity place value.
