In **science** we will continue exploring Living things and their Habitats. We aim to use a range of scientific methods to do this.

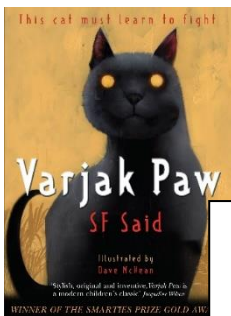
PE will be practising our track and field skills ready for sports day. We will also be looking at Bat & Ball games such as rounders and cricket.
