This term we are:

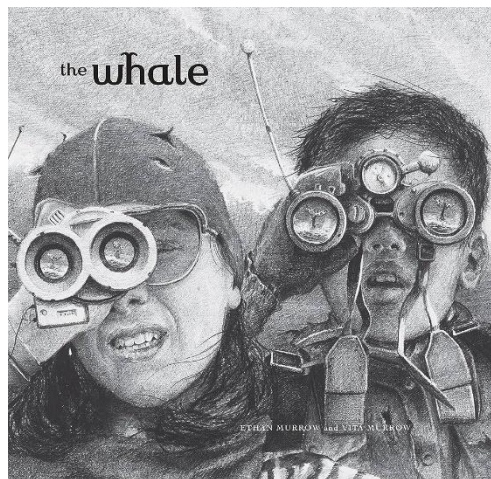
In Geography we are going to be exploring Our Region and Campania which is in Italy. We will look at the key human and geographical features and make comparisons about these! We will even look at volcanoes in those places!

In English, we will be using the book 'The Whale' by Ethan and Vita Murrow to guide our writing skills. We will focus particularly on verb inflections and writing setting narratives.

In Maths we will begin the term by looking at Place Value and we will then move on to Addition and Subtraction.

In RE our big question will be '*What do Christians learn from the creation story?*'.

In Science we will be investigating States of Matter. This unit will involve a lot of experiments, including one called 'The Hotdog Solution'!
