Coming up in Term 3!

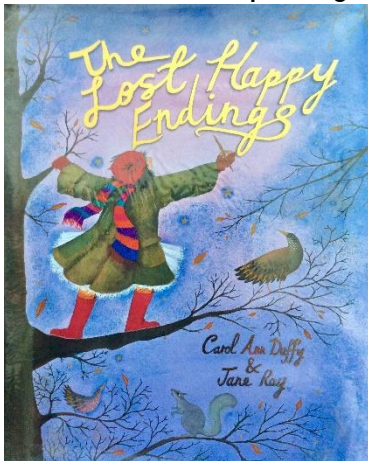
Our new class text will be *The Lost Happy Endings* by Carol Ann Duffy. We will be using this book to form a basis for our **English** learning. In English we will be looking at writing a twisted narrative and a persuasive letter. I am excited to see their creativity sparked in these units.

In **maths** we will be exploring multiplication and division. We will use practical and standard methods to help us remember strategies to speed up our multiplication and learn how these are the inverse for division. We will be looking at larger numbers in the new term and will be exploring new written methods to solve problems with them in.

In **science** we will be exploring Sound and completing a range of scientific enquiries based on this.

PE will take a focus on Dance – this will mostly be taught in the hall but outdoor kit may be required.

In **RE** we will be exploring 'What kind of world did Jesus want?'



In **history** we will be beginning to explore the early civilisations and complete an in depth study on the Ancient Egyptians. We will use historical concepts and disciplines to help us answer the question 'What were the key successes of the Ancient Egyptians?'
