Welcome back to term 4, we hope that you all had a lovely half term break. We have exciting events coming up this term – please make a note of the dates.

This term we are blasting off into space as our topic to underpin our learning. We started off our term with looking at the Oliver Jeffer's story, 'How to Catch a Star' and exploring different 2D shapes. #### World Book Day

WORLD BOOK DAY 2 MARCH 2023 World Book Day is being held on Thursday 7th March this year. We would like to extend this to the whole week from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February - Friday 8th March so that all children can participate in this event. Throughout this week we will be sharing stories, looking at different authors and if they would like to, children can dress up on any day as their favourite character. Children can bring in books from home to share with us and we will have lots of different activites planned around our favourite stories. Your child will also be receiving a World Book Day Token, which can be used in participating shops. 

## Science week

This year we will be joining the school in celebrating Science Week during the week 11<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> March. This year's theme is "Time". We have lots of exciting experiments and investigations planned and we look forward to sharing these with you via ClassDojo, you might even want to try a few of these at home!

This year Comic Relief is on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March, but to allow all children to participate, we will be raising money all week from 11<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> March.

#### **30 Hour Funding**

#### Staffing & Key person approach

In the Nursery each child is assigned a key person. Their role is to help ensure that every child's care is tailored to meet their individual needs and to help the child become familiar with the setting. To ensure consistency for all children we have made the decision to change our current key person system. Lou our qualified teacher will now be the named key person for all children. This allows her to tailor planning and learning for all children, with the rest of the staffing team supporting children's learning and development. ## Nursery Essentials
