## **Referral Criteria**

For the majority of children with SEN, needs can be met through the implementation of 'Mainstream Core Standards'. These are interventions and strategies that are universal or targeted and can be utilised in any classroom. For a very small minority difficulties may persist despite ongoing intervention and support. We may then advise a meeting with the class teacher and Inclusion Manager to discuss next steps which may include a referral to the paediatrician or other specialist.

In January the Local Health Authority revised the criteria for referrals. This included:

- Difficulties need to be significant and prevalent in school as well as at home.
- The school requires at least 2 full terms of evidence showing the impact of interventions already in place
- The NHS will NOT take referrals for children for ASD in the Reception Year.
- The NHS will only take referrals for ADHD after the age of 6.
- Referrals are seen in strict date order and cannot be prioritised under any circumstances.
- Will only accept Year 6 referrals until the end of the autumn term.

Zones of regulation are a visual tool that we use in all classrooms to help children understand their emotions.
