Uniform:

Children are expected to wear uniform everyday. This term we are:

In history we will be conducting a local field study of Newington School. We will be looking at the history of the school, its ties to the church, and how the school was run during the Victorian era!

In English, we will be reading a book called 'Rose Blanche' by Roberto Innocenti. We will look at various writing features that culminate in producing a diary entry and a bravery award speech.

In Maths we will begin the term by looking at Place Value and we will then move on to Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division.

In RE our big question will be '*Creation – Creation and Science: conflicting or complimentary?*'.

In Science we will be investigating Evolution and Inheritance – we will be looking at adaptations within animals and plants, how animals have adapted and evolved to survive over the years, and how Charles Darwin first investigated the idea of evolution.

In PE we will be recapping or basic movement skills as well as developing our skills in tag rugby.
