# NEWINGTON CE PRIMARY SCHOOL & NURSERY UNIFORM POLICY

## **Keeping Costs Low**

In order to keep costs down for our families whilst still maintaining a sense of identity and belonging, we **do not** require children to wear any items with the school logo and all uniform can be purchased from local supermarkets. However, we do insist that all cardigans or jumpers are Royal Blue. In addition, we **do not** have a separate PE Kit as our active uniform is suitable for all sports we undertake in school. For teams representing the school we provide the sports kit required (not including football boots or shin pads). Daily activity and outdoor learning are a core part of our curriculum offer, so it is important that the pupils come to school appropriately dressed with suitable footwear for sports every day.

## **Branded Items**

If you wish to purchase logoed items then you can do so from Forsters, our local supplier either in person at one of their shops or online for click and collect or delivery. There is a Forsters price list and contact details available on our website or there are printed flyers in the office.

## **Second Hand Items**

As children grow very quickly, we also run a 'new to you' programme for high quality second hand uniform. This supports our goal of being more sustainable and reducing waste and also allows parents to purchase branded items at a fraction of the cost. We have a dedicated member of staff who runs this scheme, who washes and maintains our stock and who will be able to look out for stock that meets your requirements. ## **Generic Items**

Bags - Children in reception and KS1 all require a book bag but this can be any colour or design. Children in KS2 may choose to use a soft drawstring rucksack, which again can be any colour or design. Royal blue versions (logoed or plain) are available from our supplier but also very cheaply via Amazon. Normal Rucksacks are not permitted due to space restrictions.

Coats – These should be warm and waterproof and can be of any colour or design. These may get muddy and wet, so please do not buy a designer label.

Water Bottles – All year groups require a named water bottle of any design or colour. Younger children should have a sports cap for ease of use.

## Legacy Uniform

As we move towards a fully active uniform over a period of 3 years 2022 - 2025, pupils are permitted to wear legacy uniform (grey trousers, grey skirts, grey shorts, grey pinafore, PE t-shirt on PE days, cherries nursery red sweatshirts etc.) YR will not be permitted to wear grey items from Sept 2023. New grey items should not be purchased. All pupil should wear black trainers / trainer style shoes from September 2023 to support daily sports in school.

## Nursery

Nursery pupils can wear any bottoms or shoes they wish, but should wear a white polo & Royal Blue jumper or cardigan.
