


English: In term 3 we will be reading 'Charles Darwin's, On the Origin of Species' by Sabrina Radeva. We will produce a variety of writing based on this book such as discovery narrative, an explanation and a non-chronological report.

We will also be reading 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll, which links to our topic of World War 2.



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<u>Science</u>: This term our topic in science will be 'Animals Including Humans'. We will be focusing on the circulatory system, the heart, and how diet/lifestyles can affect heart rate.

<u>PE:</u> In PE this term we will be doing Netball on a Tuesday and we will be doing gymnastics on a Friday.

<u>History</u>: For our history topic we will continue looking at WWII. As this is such a vast topic that students often thoroughly enjoy, this will be continued from our WWII learning in Term 2.
