We will be using this book to form a basis for our **English** learning. In English, we will be writing our own twisted tales and letting our imaginations run wild!

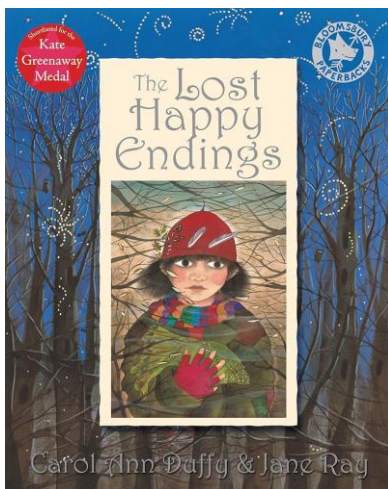
In **maths** we will continue exploring decimals, money and time.
