In **history** we will be continuing to learn about The Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings and how they settled in Britain.

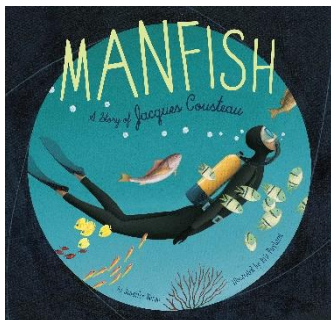
Key Vocabulary: Empire, kingdom, hostile, pillage, raid, Scandinavia, migration, invasion, monk and pagan
