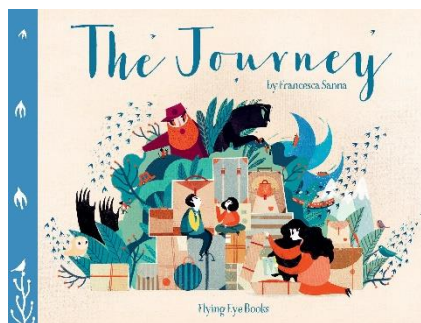
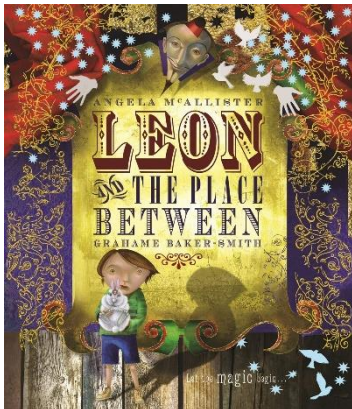
PE will take a focus on Tennis and Rounders this term.
