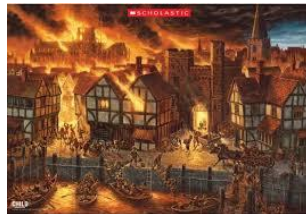

This term our English text is called 'Rosie Revere, Engineer'. We will be writing an invention narrative about a child who creates an invention and tries it out! Will it work? We are excited to find out! We will also be writing instructions on how to get the creation working!

In Maths we will be learning more about time. Last term the children worked hard on learning o'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter too. Term 6 will also introduce the children to statistics. This teaches children how to gather data using tally charts, block diagrams and pictograms. We will also be recapping our number skills of tens and ones, adding two digit numbers and practising times tables.

In history this term we will be investigating the Great fire of London! We will be learning about how it started, how it finished and how to stay safe if there was a fire.

Please ensure your child is reading at home. This term I will be starting a three read a week rule and will be checking the children's contact books ready for their transition to year 3. Please write when the child has read.



Uniform
