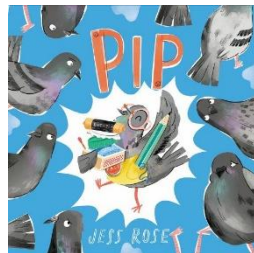
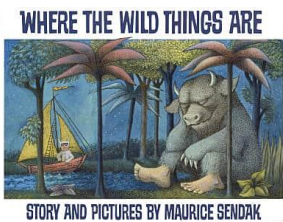
Welcome back to school. We cannot believe that it is term 4 already! Where has the time gone?

## Home Learning

**Reading:** Please ensure you are reading with your children at least three times a week and share books every day. Please record this in contact books. We will be rewarding every child who reads three times at the end of the week.
